Vermont Board of Libraries Names “Buffalo Mountain”

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 VSA §§ 151-154 relating to naming Vermont geographic locations, notice is hereby given that the Vermont Board of Libraries, on Tuesday, October 12, 2021, following a public hearing held virtually and at Vermont Department of Libraries, 60 Washington Street in Barre, Vermont, voted to name the unnamed mountain, in the town of Hardwick, county of Caledonia, Vermont, at the coordinates of Latitude: 44.5/Longitude: -72.382222, as “Buffalo Mountain.”

To ensure the standardization of geographic names on State and Federal maps, the decision was submitted to The United States Board on Geographic Names on Thursday, October, 21, 2021, which reviewed the petition and approved “Buffalo Mountain” on Thursday, December, 09, 2021.

The proposed name of “Buffalo Mountain” was brought to the Board of Libraries by citizen petition from C.M. Lance. The petitioner wished to have the historically used name of this geographic feature officially recorded by state and federal agencies as well as noted on all official maps.
