### Vermont Board of Libraries Names Bumblebee Brook

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 VSA §§ 151-154 relating to naming Vermont geographic locations, notice is hereby given that the Vermont Board of Libraries, on Tuesday, January 10, 2023, following a public hearing held virtually and at the Vermont Department of Libraries, 60 Washington Street, Barre, Vermont, voted to name the unnamed brook, located in Shelburne, County of Chittenden, Vermont, located at the coordinates of

Latitude, mouth of brook: 44.37192N; Latitude, source of brook: 44.38050N  
Longitude, mouth of brook: 73.21542W; Longitude, source of brook: 73.20418W  
as Bumblebee Brook.

The proposed name of Bumblebee Brook was brought to the Board of Libraries by citizen petition from Joplin Wistar. The brook is regularly visited and enjoyed by schoolchildren of the Treewild Forest Classroom, a school based in Shelburne, Vermont, and they had brought forward the idea to name the brook Bumblebee Brook in honor of the endangered bumblebee species that is found in the area.
