

## MAGAZINES for Children & Young Adults

The following is a basic list of the best-known children's magazines suitable for public libraries. Periodicals with a classroom educational emphasis are not included.

Children's magazines are generally not as important a part of the collection as adult periodicals. Many of them are geared for home purchase with activities such as puzzles and crafts that encourage writing in the magazine. In addition, librarians have found that children are not usually as interested in checking out periodicals as they are other materials, and so many become browsing items within the library. However, the quality in a good number is high and the variety wide; they should have a place in any juvenile collection.
