Each issue "spotlights" a subject or genre such as fantasy, biography, or women's history. As of mid-September 2014, all of their blogs will be united in one big blog called "The Booklist Reader." Includes one click ordering for Baker & Taylor's Title Source 3 and Ingram's ipage.

This covers 5000 adult and juvenile titles several weeks in advance of their publication. Reviews tend to be longer, can sometimes be cynical, and are not signed. Particularly strong in fiction. Will review self published books for a price. Lots of good features on website, such as lists of recommended books and evaluations of bestsellers (ratings are buy it, borrow it, and skip it).

Twenty issues per year: twice monthly except in January, July, August and December. \$101.99 per year for both print and digital edition for iPad. Add Book Verdict Pro: \$143.99/year. Book Verdict Pro includes everything in *Library Journal* as well as reviews from *School Library Journal*, *Horn Book Magazine*, *Horn Book Guide*, and Junior Library Guild selections. Important because patrons are most likely to request titles from it and its bestseller lists. Has a special section on children's books twice a year.

Brief reviews appear several weeks before publication and include information on promotional activities.
