WENDY WATSON EXHIBIT

This exhibit shows how a book is made, from first manuscript through completed book. All the steps of creating HICKORY STICK RAG (Crowell, 1976) are included: rough sketches, discarded sketches, color separations, progressive proofs and the printed sheet. Perfect for librarians to show children and adults all the steps of bookmaking, this exhibit may not be hung, and requires at least two long tables for display.

A series of approximately 57 mounted Children's Book Week posters produced by the Children's Book Council. Each poster is approximately 18" x 23" and is ready for hanging.
