

1. Introductory Activity:
 Pattern Spot: Does anyone see any patterns? In the room? On your clothes? We are talking about patterns today.
2. Book: *Pattern Fish*
3. Activity: Pattern Fishing
 - a. Have a set of cut-out pattern fish on cardboard or cardstock
 - b. Put the fish in a cardboard box or bowl "pond"

- c. Ask each child to pull out a fish (if you want to get fancy you can use magnets and really go fishing)
- d. Hold up the fish and finish the pattern all together

4. Book: *Blue Hat, Green Hat* by Sandra Boynton. New York, Simon & Schuster, 1984.
After reading the book, go around and make a pattern with the “Oops” in it using shoes, hats, lunchboxes, whatever.



5. Book: *Stripes, Spots or Diamonds* More ways to look for patterns.



6. Activity: Pattern Clap: Take turns clapping out patterns

OR: Pattern Jump (this was a good activity for my active group):
Jump and hop a pattern, then children do it, adding in the pattern as they go. We jumped and hopped all over the story time room.

7. Take Home Activity: Create Your Own Pattern Fish
a. Supplies:

- Construction paper, paper plates or cardstock, glue, ribbon
- b. Cut out stripes and dots, wavy lines, etc. out of construction
- c. Make up outlines of fish and cut out of paper plates or cardstock
- d. Create a “pattern fish” using different shapes
- e. Punch hole in top of fish and tie ribbon through to take home
