



Teens: Win a scholarship for a one-week workshop on cartooning!

June 19-23 or July 24-28, 2017 (a) The Center for Cartoon Studies White River Junction, Vermont

For the ninth year in a row, the Center for Cartoon Studies in White River Junction has donated a full scholarship to the Department of Libraries so a Vermont teen can attend their one-week workshop, "Create Comics," this summer.

This full scholarship, worth \$1000, includes the workshop, supplies, morning snacks, and evening student activities. Lodging is not included, but there is a very inexpensive hostel option at the nearby Hotel Coolidge. Any Vermont student age 16 or older (must be 16 years old by June 1, 2016) is eligible. The workshop takes place in White River Junction, VT on the week of your choice: June 19-23 or July 24-28, 2017.

Students interested in the scholarship should apply through their local school or public library.

Entry Requirements:

- (1) that the applicant is a Vermonter
- (2) that the applicant is at least 16 years old, and
- (3) that the applicant has the ability to attend the entire workshop

The contest will be conducted through the library (school or public) and librarians will be responsible for sending in the entry forms to the Department of Libraries by May 1, 2017. VTLIB will hold a drawing and will let the winning student's librarian know the results by May 15.
