In the above-entitled cause, the Clerk will enter:

The respondent, John Davis Buckley, is a lawyer licensed to practice law in the State of Vermont. Disciplinary counsel and respondent have filed a stipulation and attached exhibits with the Professional Responsibility Board stipulating to respondent's transfer to disability inactive status and the abeyance of pending disciplinary proceedings during the period of disability. A hearing panel of the Board has filed a report with the Court recommending that it adopt the recommendation. Having reviewed the stipulation and exhibits, and the hearing panel's report, the Court finds that respondent currently suffers from a disability which adversely affects his ability to practice law, and therefore, pursuant to Rule 21.C of Administrative Order 9, orders:

1. That respondent is transferred to disability inactive status, effective from the date of this order, until further order of the Court; and
2. That respondent shall comply with all of the provisions of Rule 23 of Administrative Order 9.






