BEANSTACK TERMINOLOGY

Account Creator vs. Reader

- An account creator is someone who initially **signed up** and created a Beanstack account.
- A reader is the person participating in the program, or the person for whom the account creator is doing the logging

NOTE: These may be synonymous, especially for adults and teens.

BEANSTACK TERMINOLOGY

Challenge – The overarching reading initiative

- Episodic: Has a beginning and end such as Summer reading
 - Reader's age determines eligibility
- Ongoing:
 - Readers age in and out of challenge
 - 1,000 books before Kindergarten, 100 books before college

BEANSTACK TERMINOLOGY

Reader Experience vs Administrative Access Reader Experience

• Each Reader has their own main page within an account. This is their dashboard where they can switch between challenges, log and earn badges.

Administrative Access (staff dashboard)

• Staff can access patron accounts through this dashboard, to update accounts, create accounts, log and redeem prizes on behalf of patrons.


- Add and edit user accounts

CREATING USER ACCOUNTS

- Family account vs individual
- Required fields in red
- Email is optional
- Age is required and determines available challenges
- Grade is optional
- Username is for the entire family or group
- * See Training video on Creating and finding User accounts




- Defaults to first user created in family account


READING LOGS

- All others are minutes




EDIT ACCOUNT CREATOR INFORMATION


- Can not see password but can reset it here

Is this person registering as a reader?




How does someone access the Beanstack mobile app?
