**Introduction and Definitions**

*DOL collects many statistics from public libraries which it uses to justify expenditures, budget requests, as well as to provide information to state and federal officials and legislators. School libraries are substantial users of DOL services and those statistics are equally important. Thanks to all of you who provided your statistics.*

*Please remember we ask that any school library using DOL services return a statistical report with as much data as available, otherwise we cannot adequately justify the services we provide to school libraries and continuation of those services may be jeopardized.*

**SCHOOL DISTRICT/ TOWN/SCHOOL NAME**

**School population** – students, faculty/staff, total

**STAFFING**

The number of hours worked in a typical week by people paid by the school to do library work as of the last day of the school year most recently completed. Includes unfilled /vacant positions.

**LIBN W/ ALA-MLS** – weekly hours worked by person(s) holding the title of librarian/director AND holding a master's degree from a program accredited by the American Library Association.

**LIBN W/ OTH MASTERS** – weekly hours worked by persons holding the title of librarian/director AND holding a master's degree in another subject area.

**LIBN W/O MASTERS** – weekly hours worked by persons holding the title of librarian/director without a master's degree.

**FTELIBNS** – number of fulltime equivalents holding the title of librarian/director (based on 40 hrs. per week).

**OTHSTAFF** – Hours worked by all other employees paid including assistant librarians, paraprofessionals, clerks, aides, etc.

**TOTFTE** – number of fulltime equivalents on the library staff (based on 40 hrs. per week).

**VOLHRS** – Total volunteer hours in a typical week - include volunteers and student workers who serve the public as well as those who work behind the scenes.

**HRSOPEN** – per week, winter/summer

## **EXPENSES**

Operating expenditures (*if paid from library budget*).

**COLLEXP** – Amount spent for books, periodicals, and non-book materials for all ages - all items purchased or leased for use by the public. Does not include supplies, processing, or programming costs.

**ELEC FMT EXP** – Amount spent for materials in electronic format - the number of CD-ROMs, magnetic disks, and other items designed for use with a computer.

**ELEC DB EXP** – Amount spent for electronic databases (VOL, EBSCO, InfoTrac, etc.).

**ACCESSEXP** – Amount spent for electronic access - include software, telecommunications, maintenance. Does not include capital expenditures.

**OTHEXP** – Other operating expenditures - all other operating expenses not included above, such as programming, supplies, etc.

**TOTEXP** – total operating expenditures. Does not include capital expenses.

**GRANTS** – Amount received from grants, if any.

## **HOLDINGS**

**COLLEXP** – Amount spent for books, periodicals, and non-book materials for all ages - all items purchased or leased for use by the public. Does not include supplies, processing, or programming costs.

**COLLEXP PER STUDENT** – Amount spent for books, periodicals, and non-book materials per student derived by dividing Collection Expense by Student Population.

**ADBKS/JUVBKS/BOOKS** – Books (volumes) (adult/juvenile/total) - non-periodical printed publications bound in hard or soft covers, or in loose-leaf format, of at least 49 pages, exclusive of the cover pages; or juvenile non-periodical publications of any length bound in hard or soft covers. (Juvenile generally refers to people under the age of 14.)

**VOLS PER STUDENT** - volumes of books owned per student, derived by dividing Books by Student Population

**AUDIO** – materials on which sound (only) are stored (recorded) and that can be reproduced (played back) mechanically or electronically, or both, including records, audiocassettes, audio books, etc.

**VIDEO** – materials on which pictures, sound or both are recorded and played back using a television receiver or monitor.

**ELECFMT** – Materials in electronic format - number of physical units such as CD-ROMs and magnetic disks designed to be used with a computer.

**SUBSCRIP** – Total periodical subscriptions received, both purchased or as gifts (either adult or juvenile). Does not include the number of individual issues but rather each title received.

## **CIRCULATION**

**ADCIRC/JUVCIRC/CIRC** – Annual circulation (adult/juvenile/total) - transactions that involve lending an item from the collection for use outside the library. Includes circulation of all formats, whether owned by the library or borrowed in collections from the Department of Libraries or other library. Does not include items borrowed specifically for patrons on interlibrary loan. (Juvenile generally refers to people under the age of 14.)

**CIRC PER STUDENT** – circulation per student, derived by dividing Total Circulation (CIRC) by Student Population.

### **Annual interlibrary loans (ILLs):**

(a) **ILL TO OTHERS** – Number of ILLs provided to other libraries - items a library sends to another library upon request

(b) **ILL RECD** – Number of ILLs received from other libraries - items a library specifically requests and borrows from another library, including regional libraries, for a patron. Does not include bulk loans (collections) from the Dept. of Libraries.

## **SERVICES AND PROGRAMMING**

**VISITS** – Total number of people who enter the library in a typical day including those attending programs and meetings and those requiring no staff services (such as a class accompanied by a teacher, or a student with a tutor).

**VISITS PER STUDENT** – Visits per student, derived by dividing Visits by Student Population.

**REF TRANS** – Reference transactions in a typical day - Information contacts involving the knowledge, use, recommendations, interpretation, or instruction in the use of one or more information sources by a member of the library staff. The term includes information and referral service. Also includes transactions when a staff member uses information gained from previous use of information sources to answer a question, even if the source is not consulted again during the current transaction. Does not include directional transactions (e.g., "where's the bathroom?")

**REFTRANS PER STUDENT** – Reference transactions per student, derived by dividing RefTrans by Student Population.

**TOT PRGMS** – Yearly Total Programs a library offers – includes weekly storyhours/booktalks or any series of programs as separate programs.

**COOP PRGMS** – Number of these programs that were sponsored cooperatively with other organizations or agencies (e.g., scouts, public library, Head Start, Success by Six) in a community.

**PRGMS ATTEND** – Total attendance - number of people who attended library-sponsored programs.

**TRAIN SESS** – Yearly Total Training Sessions (planned events)(formal student/staff training, study skills or computer skills taught in or out of the library by library staff).

## **COMPUTER SERVICES**

**ELEC FMT EXP** – Amount spent for materials in electronic format - the number of CD-ROMs, magnetic disks, and other items designed for use with a computer.

**ELEC DB EXP** – Amount spent for electronic databases (VOL, EBSCO, InfoTrac, etc.).

**ACCESSEXP** – Amount spent for electronic access - include software, telecommunications, maintenance. Does not include capital expenditures.

**#PCs** – Total number of computers workstations in the library, including those used by staff.

**#PUBPCs** – Number of computer workstations available for public use. This may include computers that are also used by staff.

**PCUSERS PER DAY** – In typical day, how many people used the library's computers for any reason?

**INTERNET? N/Y (HS or D)** – Does the library have internet access? If yes, is the access high speed (HS) (e.g. cable, ISDN, DSL, Frame Relay, etc.) or dial-up (D).

**ELEC DB OFFERED? N/Y** – Does the library offer electronic databases to students, faculty and staff?

**ELEC DBS** – If yes, what databases does the library offer (selected)?
