#### **Directions to Fletcher Memorial Library, 88 Main St., Ludlow**

Ludlow is in south central Vermont, at the junction of Routes 103 and 100.

**From I-91:** Take **exit 8** and follow **Rte. 131 West** through Cavendish until the road meets Rte. 103. Turn **right onto 103** and drive about **3 miles into Ludlow**. The Fletcher Memorial Library will be on your left, across from a small town green with a gazebo.

**From Rte. 7:** take **Rte. 140** (Wallingford) or **Rte. 103** (Clarendon) **East to Ludlow**. The Fletcher Memorial Library is on the East end of town after most of the shops, on your right, across from a small town green with a gazebo.

Parking is behind the library where the primary entrance is. There is a small DOL workshop going on that day also, so parking may be a little tight. There is parking on the street.
