

RDA & MARC

- Resource Description and Access (RDA) came along in 2010 as a result of a more than decade long
 project by a group of people who wanted to improve AACR2. This group, called the Joint Steering
 Committee, saw at the time that AACR2 does not fit the modern computing environment very
 well, and does not take advantage of the internet & the ability to link data.
- "Back in 2010, Chris Oliver of the University of Ottawa, author of Introducing RDA: A Guide to the Basics (2010), explained that RDA demands precise data. Precise data equals machine readable data."

- RDA (and before that AACR2) are rules about how to express a book (what elements of the material)
- MARC is the framework for cataloging that data (the **fields** for the elements)

Field Formatting

Content Designators: [Numerical Tag] [Indicators] [Delimiter][Subfield]

- [Numerical Tag] : three-digit number for a field specifically for an element, some repeatable (noted R or NR in MARC21 handbook)
- [Indicators] : two spaces that follow the tag, two one-digit codes or "#" for null
- [Delimiter] : character \$, ≠, ‡, or _ to show a new element of information is coming
- [Subfield] : letters and numbers representing different information components (some may not be applicable), some repeatable (noted R or NR in MARC21 handbook)



Field Formatting Cont. [Numerical Tag] [Indicators] & [Delimitator][Subfields]

- Indicators & Subfields: Change meaning depending on the numerical tag
- Indicators & Delimitators: Information for computer processing
- Subfields: Punctuation matters
- Expand abbreviations
- ~10% of tags are always used, ~90% are used occasionally or rarely
