Resources & Training Outside of VTLIB

- United for Libraries, American Library Association
 - Annual Conference cost of registration, potential travel cost

 - Provides support to nonprofit boards through written resources, guides, and publications
 - On demand certificate program for Nonprofit Board Education
 - Annual membership fee ranges from \$500-\$3,250
