

## Vermont Summer Reading 2022 Challenge Staff Preview

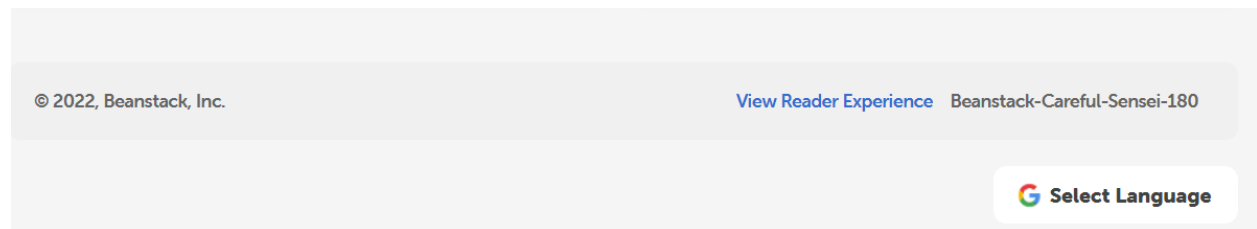
We have created a staff preview of the challenge to encourage you to become familiar with the Summer Reading challenge and the Beanstack interface. The challenge is duplicated version of what is being offered to patrons. This document will walk you through how to “participate” in the challenge by logging reading minutes, participating in activity challenges, and writing book reviews.

### 1. Login to your library admin page

Since it is a “staff challenge” you will first have to log in to your library admin account. If you need a refresher on how to do this refer to [this page](#).

### 2. View Reader Experience

Once you are logged in, Click on “View Reader Experience” in the bottom right corner of the admin landing page.



It may ask you to update information for the adult reader account attached to each admin account. You can just click through it but do not need to update any information related to that account. Now you should be able to see a challenge that is called **STAFF PREVIEW - Vermont Summer Reading 2022 Challenge (All ages)** with the adult reader account attached to each admin account.

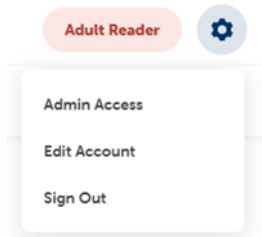
### 3. Register and “participate” in the challenge

The STAFF PREVIEW is a copy of the 2022 Summer Reading Challenge so you can get the reader experience before it is available to the public. Feel free to “log minutes read” and “participate” in the activity badges. You do not need to read books to log reading minutes or fully complete the activities to earn them for the preview, but we do encourage you read through all the activities and view supporting links. This intended to help you get a feel for the challenge so you can better promote it and incorporate it into your summer programming.



4. When you are done with the reader view you can click on the gear icon in top right corner to go back to the admin view by clicking “Admin Access”.
