



According to the World Health Organization, approximately 3.3 million people die prematurely each year from causes directly linked to air pollution, including such examples include aggravations of asthma, emphysema, bronchitis, lung disease, and heart disease. Air contamination is divided into two broad categories: primary and secondary, with primary pollutants those released directly into the air, including dust, smoke, and a variety of toxic chemicals, such as lead, mercury, vinyl chloride and carbon monoxide. The exhaust from vehicles and industrial smokestacks are examples of primary pollution. Secondary...
